

Celloman

The Celloman electric band or Acoustic trio will play pieces from various Celloman albums for a period of 100 – 120 mins either as 1 long set or 2 sets with an interval.

Option 1: Electric Full Band:

Includes 6 x Musicians – Cello, Violin, Percussion, Bass, Guitar & Drums + **Sound engineer.**

This option requires PA, stage lighting + Stage area. (1)

Option 2: Electric Quartet:

Includes 4 x Musicians – Cello, Guitar, Bass & Drums + **Sound engineer.**

This option requires PA, stage lighting + Stage area. (1)

Option 3: Electric Trio:

Includes 3 x Musicians – Cello, Violin / Guitar & Percussion.

The trio play over programmed drums & bass and contains live looping.

This option can include PA and basic stage lighting.

Option 4: Electric Duo:

Includes 2 x Musicians – Cello & Violin or Cello & Guitar

The Duo plays over programmed drums & bass and contains live looping.

This option can include PA and basic stage lighting.

Option 5: Electric Solo Cello:

Cello plays over programmed drums & bass and contains live looping.

This option can include PA and basic stage lighting.

Option 6: Acoustic String Trio:

Performed by a trio of Violin, Viola & Cello.

This option contains compositions taken from the albums: Celloman Acoustic Collection Vol.1 & 2, plus arrangements of other Celloman tracks.

This option is best for small rooms without PA.

This option can include PA and basic stage lighting.

Option 7: Acoustic Solo Cello:

Ivan plays pieces from the album 'Arpezzato', a new style of Cello playing that utilises the fingers on both hands with no bow.

This option can include PA and basic stage lighting.
